

LOCATION

PLANNING PERMISSION

Outline Planning Permission dated 2011 was previously granted but has now lapsed. A copy of the lapsed Planning Permission will be provided to interested parties for guidance only. The seller will accept an offer subject to planning.





SFRVICES

Road

The seller will construct the access road serving the development from the main public road to a standard suitable for adoption by the local roads authority (there will be no guarantee that the road will eventually be adopted). Maintenance of the roadway following construction will be according to user.

Drainage

Drainage will be by way of a private drainage system situated wholly within the site and to be constructed by the purchaser at their sole cost.

Electricity

Connection for electricity and telephone are adjacent to the site.

Water

There is currently no water supply to the plot. A mains water supply is located on land to the east owned by Burton Property Trust. The seller at their own cost will use their best endeavours to obtain a servitude right to lay a water supply pipe through Trust land to connect into the mains. The seller will accept an offer subject to this.

DIRECTIONS

Travel to Glenelg. Just as you reach the outskirts of the village turn right along the road signposted Galltair. Travel down that road for approximately a mile and the site is located on the right hand side of the main road.
